Join us in Denmark for an eventful seminar

Royal historic buildings

This year's seminar takes place just north of Copenhagen at Skodsborg Kurhotel & Spa A/S, which has a history of more than 100 years. First royalty and later healthcare. The royal history began with King Frederik VII, who bought the estate in 1852. In 1878, the buildings were renovated and extended to their present form. An American doctor bought the buildings in 1898 and Skodsborg Kurhotel/Bathing Sanatorium was founded.

In 1992, it was sold and renamed Skodsborg Health Centre. It is however, also a hotel and conference centre, and you are thus offered an excellent opportunity to pamper yourself. Once you have registered for the seminar, you will receive a letter of confirmation together with further information on Skodsborg Kurhotel, etc.

Seminar Programme

On Wednesday afternoon, we will host a reception in the Bank at Vesterbrogade 9, and we invite you to enjoy a drink and a buffet. This offers you the opportunity to visit our offices, meet the staff and make an appointment with your account manager.

Sightseeing

Friday afternoon

Either a visit to Louisiana

We will go by bus to the Louisiana Museum of Modern Art situated in a spacious, old park with a fine view across the sound to Sweden.

Or a visit to the Viking Ship Museum

We will go by bus to The Viking Ship Museum, which houses the five original viking ships excavated in Roskilde Fjord.

If requested

If you are a golfer, we will be pleased to try to arrange for you to play one of the many courses in the vicinity of Copenhagen.

Sunday

Either a visit to Rungstedlund, lunch at Hotel Marienlyst and a visit to Kronborg Castle – by bus

We will start with a guided tour of Rungstedlund, where Karen Blixen, the world-famous Danish author, spent most of her life. We will proceed to a lunch buffet at Hotel Marienlyst and go on to a guided tour at Kronborg Castle, which is one of the most significant renaissance castles of northern Europe. Duration: 9.15-16.15.

Or take a cruise onboard Maja on the Sound, visit Middelgrundsfortet and lunch onboard Maja

Maja, a three-masted 43-metre long schooner, will sail us into the Sound to Middelgrundsfortet, where we will moor for a guided tour. The fortress was built in 1890-94 and is one of Denmark's largest structures. On the way back, we offer you a buffet lunch onboard Maja. Duration: 09.30-15.30.

Gala dinner

On Saturday evening, we invite you to a gala dinner in the historic mansion, Odd Fellow Palæet. While dining, the Eskær Trio, a prize Danish piano trio, will play for you. In addition, three of Denmark's finest opera singers, will offer you a taste of their repertoire.
